I am writing today on behalf of Holistic Pediatric Consulting and offering my commitment and support in the joint efforts between ImmunoE Health Centers and Lily Grace Foundation for the grant proposal being submitted to HRSA AND MCHB to fund a Resource Center to improve the health of infants, children and adolescents who have, or are at risk for developing ASD and other developmental disabilities. I am the author of, 'Preventing Autism & ADHD'; Controlling Risk Factors Before, During, and after Pregnancy.
